

Get ready for Winter! Here we go—heater time!

HEATER (available yearround, but really needed October to May)

Your heat comes from a high efficiency baseboard heater. The thermostat is the dial on the end of each heater. Be patient while you are first identifying your comfortable setting. The heaters provide *soft heat* which means it slowly but efficiently heats your space.

Remember, it is a thermostat, so when the daytime temperature rises, the heater automatically turns itself down or off. Once you find your comfortable setting, there's no need to fiddle with it. It will come on when the room gets too cool; and turn off when that southern sun has heated the space.

Should you be gone for an extended period during the winter, you may want to dial down that comfortable setting, but don't turn it all the way off. We don't want your pipes to freeze.

Remember, your summer thermostat on the wall; your winter thermostat on the end of the baseboard heater.
